The potjies offered are Beef, Chicken and Vegetarian and bring you a true taste of wood-smoked Africa.

The Zambezi Explorer's upper 'Signature Deck' is utter sophistication, and you are encouraged to relax into the deep-set couches that reflect the earthy tones and river blues found in the surrounds. Enjoy appetizing canapés and the services of a dedicated mixologist. There is always a host onboard to

ensure you're well looked after, and on return to the Pure Africa Waterfront, you'll be treated to a traditional African song of the crew's choice, one that will add further soul to the setting.

Beyond the 'Signature Deck,' the Zambezi Explorer's two 'Luxury Decks' are beautifully fitted with Ndebele-patterned chairs, generous lounge seating and views through linen curtains gently holding back the afternoon breeze. As you cruise the watery wilderness with the spray of the Victoria Falls as your backdrop, canapés and drinks are served. Important to note that our canapés are prepared by the chef on board and served deliciously fresh straight from the boat's kitchen, definitely adding to the flavour.

On return to the Pure Africa Waterfront, stay with us for dinner at The Eatery, gathering around the fire-pit on the water's edge to recap on a day well spent, before following the perfectly placed lanterns to your table for dinner. Grunting hippos, the call of the fiery-necked nightjar and distant yip of the jackals for company. This is a seamless option that will leave you in Pure Africa's care until your after-dinner transfer gets you safely back to your accommodation.
